

Morgantown Plumbers Joint Apprenticeship Committee JATC

Qualifications For Apprenticeship

- Applicants must be 18 years of age or older. An applicant who is 17 at the time of application can apply as long as their 18th birthday is prior to be registered by the JATC
- Applicants shall be required to take the TABE test, given by WorkForce West Virginia specifically for the Morgantown Plumbers JATC. No other test will be accepted. Individuals passing the 10th grade level test or higher will be granted an interview. Testing information will be provided at the time of applications..
- Applicants shall: 1. Be a high school graduate or the equivalent; 2. Furnish a diploma; 3. Provide high school transcript or official report of the GED test results or their equivalent; 4. provide a birth certificate at time of application, to be kept on file. Copies of the above are required.
- US military veterans with an honorable discharge (active duty or reservist) must submit a dd-214 for consideration of credit for training and experience.
- Applicants will be subject to a substance abuse test before enrolling in the program.
- Applicants shall be bona fide residents of the following counties (proof of residency required): Barbour, Braxton, Doddridge, Gilmer, Grant, Hampshire, Hardy, Harrison, Lewis, Marion, Mineral, Monongalia, Pendleton, Preston, Randolph, Taylor, Tucker, or Upshur.
- A current valid driver's license is mandatory and must be supplied at the time of application.
- A \$20 application fee will be charged. Cash or check only.

The Recruitment, selection, employment and training of apprentices shall be without discrimination because of race, color, religion, national origin or sex. The JATC will take affirmative action to provide equal opportunities in apprenticeship and training and will operate the apprenticeship program as required under Title 29 of the code of federal regulations, Part 30.
