The following are minimum requirements; the lack of any one will automatically disqualify the applicant. No applicant will be rejected because of sex, race, color or natural origin.

1. Age – Minimum 18 years by September 1, 2019.
2. Applicants shall be a high school graduate or provide proof of equivalent educational attainment through such means as an official report of successful results of the G.E.D (Test of General Educational Development). Note: Upcoming 2019 graduates are also eligible to apply.
3. Applicants must be able to pass a physical examination if deemed necessary, and be physically able to perform the work of the Plumber/Pipefitter.
4. Applicants must pass a drug test prior to employment.
5. Applicants must reside within the jurisdiction of the Plumbers & Steamfitters Local #83 which is as follows:

WEST VIRGINIA: In Brooke County, all area south of SR 27 due east to the state line and west to the Ohio River: Ohio, Marshall, and Wetzel Counties in their entireties.

OHIO: In Jefferson County, all area south of SR 150 from the Ohio River to the east and the point of merger with SR 250 to the county line of Jefferson and Harrison County to the west: Belmont County in its entirety; and in Monroe County, north of SR 78 east to the Ohio River and west to the county line.
